ABC 123 Tutoring

This program is for children in grades 3 to 6 with a diagnosed LD and/or ADHD. Tutoring focuses on basic reading, writing and math skills. A to Z Reading and JUMP Math are used in a small group setting. Concepts taught are reinforced with games and hands-on activities. (7-week session)

BEST Social Skills – Foundations

This program is for children 8-12 years of age with a diagnosed LD and/or ADHD. Social skills training will build effective communication techniques for everyday situations using role playing games, and positive reinforcement. The training will focus on direct instruction to assist participants to successfully interact at home and school. (7-week session)

LEGO Club for Social Skills (for ADHD)

LEGO Club for Social Skills is a collaborative play group in which children work together to build LEGO models. Children practice key skills of collaboration, joint attention, fair division of labour, sharing, turn taking, eye contact, gaze-following, verbal and nonverbal communication. LEGO Club provides the opportunity for social communication, social support, social problem-solving and conflict resolution skills. This program has been designed for students ages 7-12 years old diagnosed with ADHD. (6-week session)

Brainology

Examples of activities include laser tag, mini-golf, swimming, bowling, seeing a movie, ice cream social, etc. (3-month session)

This course will focus on keyboarding, file management & organization, using a digital calendar, researching effectively using the internet, Google Apps for Education, and smart social media use. This course is intended for students in grades 3-6. (4-week session)

SOAR (Some Assembly Required) Transition Planning Program

This program is for youth entering grades 6-9 with a diagnosed learning disability and/or ADHD. Topics discussed include: L's and D's (understanding your learning disability), tools for success (strategies, support, and accommodation), and making choices for the future (keys to success and goal setting). Each participant will get their own workbooks to record their work. Many of the concepts taught will be reinforced with games and hands-on activities, with incentives being provided to promote participation. (8-week session)
