

## 2020 SPRING PROGRAM GUIDE



### **ABC 123 Tutoring**

This program is for children in grades 3 to 6 with a diagnosed LD and/or ADHD. Tutoring focuses on basic reading, writing and math skills. A to Z Reading and JUMP Math are used in a small group setting. Concepts taught are reinforced with games and hands-on activities.  
(7-week session)

### **Youth Recreation – (April-June)**

For **youth 13-17 years of age** with a diagnosed learning disability and/or ADHD.

### **Young Adult Rec – (April- June)**

Similar to our youth recreational program, this program is for individuals **18-25 years of age**. The purpose of this program is to create a space for socialization and fun.

Activities may include: movie nights, bowling, and more.

**Cost:** \$20.00 per 3-month session

### **SET (Supported Employment Training)**

Participants aged 15+ will:

- develop resumes
- complete mock interviews
- develop job search techniques

Participants will learn how learning disabilities and ADHD affect all aspects of their lives, determine their strengths and weaknesses to succeed in an interview and on the job.

(8-week session) || **Cost:** Free

### **BEST Social Skills- Dealing with Emotions (2)** **Must have BEST – Foundations (1) prior to Dealing with Emotions (2).**

This program is for children in grades 3-6 with a diagnosed LD and/or ADHD. Social skills training will build effective communication techniques, for everyday situations, using role playing games and positive reinforcement. The training will focus on direct instruction, to assist participants to successfully interact at home and school. (7-week session)

\$150 non-LDA members / \$100 for LDA members

### **BEST Social Skills- Foundations (1)**

This program is for children in grades 3-6 with a diagnosed LD and/or ADHD. Social skills training will build effective communication techniques, for everyday situations, using role playing games and positive reinforcement. Topics include: group behaviour, listening, body language, and more  
(7-week session)
