Junior Undiscovered Math Prodigy (JUMP) Math is an individualized tutoring program for children who are a minimum of one year behind in math due to a diagnosed, identified, or suspected math disability and may be showing signs of math anxiety.

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GROWTH MINDSET (GR 3-6) (VIRTUAL)

This twice-weekly virtual reading program helps children develop a Growth Mindset. Using popular children's books and Social and Emotional Learning, children develop resilience through regular practice to attain long-term learning goals, like literacy skills, that support young students on their lifelong reading journey.

READING ROCKS (GR 2-7) (VIRTUAL)

Reading Rocks is a virtual individualized reading intervention program for children who are a minimum of one year behind in literacy due to a diagnosed, identified, or suspected reading disability. Children work with a trained tutor to engage in activities and games that teach essential literacy concepts while building children's motivation and fostering self-regulation.

1:1 TUTORING (GR 1-8) (VIRTUAL)

Our virtual tutoring program is for families seeking tutoring support for their children. This program pairs children with an OCT (Ontario Certified Teacher) to work with them on a 1:1 basis to solidify concepts learned in the classroom.




HACK YOUR HOMEWORK (VIRTUAL) MONDAYS (GR 7-12)
