Our Barton Tutoring Program is a specialized, one-on-one tutoring initiative that illuminates written language's phonemic structure through a multi-sensory framework. Immersive 50-minute sessions are meticulously crafted to meet individual requirements, and scheduling sessions twice weekly is recommended to ensure consistent progress. A 50-minute introductory session with our Barton coordinator is essential to facilitate a seamless start to your tutoring journey.
