Position: Senior Lead Facilitator – Sky High Summer Recreation Camp 2026

Details:

As the Lead Facilitator at Sky High Summer Camp, you will lead the delivery of a high-quality recreational program grounded in HIGH FIVE® principles of healthy child development. You will oversee daily camp operations, support and guide staff, and ensure a safe, inclusive, and engaging environment for children entering grades 2 through 6.

You will coordinate and lead themed activities focused on active play, teamwork, outdoor experiences, and creative projects, ensuring all programming promotes participation, confidence, and positive experiences for children.

Duties:

- Plan and lead engaging recreational activities for individuals and groups, including games, outdoor play, and themed programming
- Support and provide direction to camp staff to ensure high-quality program delivery
- Create a fun, inclusive environment that builds confidence, participation, and a sense of belonging
- Adapt activities to meet a range of abilities, interests, and support needs
- Promote positive behaviour and respond to challenges using supportive strategies
- Supervise children to ensure a safe, clean, and well-organized environment
- Track attendance, maintain program records, and complete basic evaluations
- Deliver strong customer service and maintain positive relationships with families
- Communicate regularly with the Executive Director and team members

- Maintain accurate program data (e.g., attendance, class lists, reports)
- Follow all Occupational Health & Safety guidelines and organizational procedures
- Support program operations across locations as needed and assist with additional duties as required

Required/Preferred Qualifications:

- Currently enrolled in or completed post-secondary education in Education, Child and Youth Care, Recreation and Leisure, Social Work, Psychology, or a related field
- Experience working with children in camps or recreational programs is preferred
- Ability to create safe, inclusive, and engaging environments for children
- Strong behaviour management skills, including the ability to support and redirect challenging behaviours
- Strong communication and organizational skills
- Ability to plan and adapt age-appropriate activities for a range of needs
- Patient, creative, and flexible approach
- Understanding of learning disabilities and ADHD is an asset

Conditions of Employment:

- Satisfactory, up-to-date Police Clearance required
- Current First Aid and CPR certification required or willingness to obtain
- Willingness to complete required training in play leadership and healthy child development

- be a Canadian citizen, permanent resident, or person to whom refugee protection has been conferred;
